Preschool Program:

- Flexible schedule designed to fit individual needs
 - Choose from one to five days per week
 - Choose from the half-day (6:30 A.M. - 1:00 P.M.) or full-day (6:30 A.M. - 6:00 P.M.) program
- Zoophonics pre-reading and pre-spelling programs are designed specifically for preschoolers
- Pre-reading, pre-writing, pre-math, science and social skills are taught via creative, hands-on activities

Elementary School Program:

- Well rounded curriculum meets or exceeds state standards in Bible, English, math, science, and history
- Individualized learning through Accelerated Reader and Accelerated Math programs
- Extracurricular activities taught by specialists in PE, music, computers and library
- After school ED-venture Electives offer additional learning opportunities

Junior High School Program:

- Home-base teachers are assigned to each student to provide mentoring and consistency
- Well rounded curriculum meets or exceeds state standards in Bible, English, math, science, history, and PE
- Strong athletic program provides opportunities for students to participate in a variety of team sports
